A native of Coffeyville, Kan., Dr. Watson was named an Alumni Fellow at Kansas State in 2015, and was also honored by being named the Kansas Superintendent of the Year.



Bruce Woner Legal Update

has more than 37 years of banking experience and has worked with hundreds of banks, from Wyoming to Illinois and from South Dakota to Oklahoma. Challenges he has addressed include regulatory problems, management issues, mergers, acquisitions and technology issues. His experience also includes time in Siberia and eastern Russia advising on issues related to Russia's economic collapse in the 1990s, and later as an advisor in the Republic of Georgia, Yemen and Iraq. Deines will discuss the history of the Robbins Banking Institute, why it was formed, the curriculum and what's coming next.

Across the country, skimmers and the cloned cards they produce are costing banks millions of dollars as a result of fraudulent transactions, re-issued cards and damaged reputations. Mike will

She joined Farmers & Drivers Bank as Vice President in 2010. Her previous experience includes working for Senator Bob Dole in Washington, DC and serving as a counsel to the US House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure and the Committee on Government Reform and Oversight. In 2001, she was appointed by President George W. Bush to serve as an executive at the Federal Emergency Management Agency and, upon its establishment, at the Department of Homeland Security as Deputy Assistant Secretary and Policy Advisor to Secretary Tom Ridge.
